Chowdhury family – situation worsens

After this weeks slamming report on the immigration of children, two children from Liverpool now sit alone without parents in Yarls Wood Detention Center in Bedford. Nazifa 12 and Ishtiaque 16 are being held awaiting deportation tomorrow. The brother and sister were seized in Liverpool on Tuesday after a judge ruled that they face no danger if sent back to Bangladesh where they fled after being kidnapped and tortured. The Judge ruled, since their father's death last year that they are no longer at risk. Jannatul, their mother, was last night rushed to A&E in Bedford with severe abdominal pains only a few hours after the Home Office had dismissed doctor's advice regarding Mrs Chowdhury's condition. Nazifa is also undergoing treatment at Alder Hey Hospital, Liverpool, for neurological problems. So far the Home Office has refused to make comment.
